Attention students currently in 6th, 7th, and 8th grade: Join us for one or more week-long Career Exploration Camps at Camden County Technical Schools.

The Summer Career Camps at CCTS will provide your child the opportunity to learn introductory skills, form new relationships with their peers, and learn more about themselves and their future goals by exploring different career pathways. Campers will also learn 21st Century life skills such as: working collaboratively with other campers, practicing time management, presenting ideas and project status to campers and staff, and acquiring team building skills.

FAST FACTS:

- Licensed teachers in their respective fields and student mentors will conduct the Camps in our safe, state-of-the-art facilities.
- Camps are offered at both our Gloucester Township and Pennsauken Campuses (see schedule for dates and locations).
- Registration is open as of 3/8/19. Camps will close individually as they reach capacity. Parents will receive confirmation letter.
- Cost is \$150 per week. Check or credit card payments accepted via our website: ccts.org. **Refunds not permitted after 6/1/19.**
- Camp runs daily from 8 am to 3 pm. Families/parents provide transportation to and from Camp.
- Students bring their own lunch each day of camp.
- On the last day of Camp, family and friends are invited to attend a **Skills Showcase**. Detailed information will be provided.
- Campers receive a tee shirt and a Certificate of Completion.

AIR FORCE JUNIOR CADET CAMP (Tuition \$150 - 1 Week) GTC 7/8–7/12

Junior Cadet Camp will be a challenging week-long course designed to hone leadership skills and increase confidence. Cadets will learn about the Air Force, Aerospace Science, military drill (marching), fitness and leadership. Activities will emphasize the importance of teamwork and team building. Training will be led by Retired Air Force Instructors and current Air Force JROTC Cadets.

BEAUTY CAMP (Tuition \$150 – 1 Week) GTC 7/22-7/26 and 7/29–8/2

Beauty camp will familiarize participants with methods to meet their basic personal care needs such as hair care, manicuring, and skincare. Campers will learn how to do thermal styling (straightening, curling, etc.), blow-drying techniques, creative hairstyling, formal hairstyling, and braiding from a licensed cosmetology teacher. Campers will also learn about skin care and nutrition, the process of a proper manicure and pedicure, including how to apply nail art and how to groom eyebrows. Camp will conclude with participants enjoying a spa day and a hot paraffin treatment.

CODING CAMP (Tuition \$150 – 1 Week) GTC 7/29 – 8/2 and PC 7/22 – 7/26

Think there's a way you could make the next Google? Instagram? Candy Crush? Then sign up for Coding Camp! Participants will learn entry-level skills, such as how to build apps and games, as well as the programming concepts behind mobile applications. In small teams, students will create and present a mobile game app using Scratch, a simple graphical interface that lets those with no programming experience create a basic app that they can play on their own device! It is a great way for youngsters to learn how to program. Students don't need to learn coding syntax or language to be successful. No prior skills required for this Camp.

CONSTRUCTION CAMP (Tuition \$150 – 1 Week) GTC 7/8 –7/12 and PC 7/15 – 7/19

Campers will gain insight into various careers in the construction industry by participating in hands-on activities and learning the basics of blueprint reading, carpentry, and electric. They will also learn how to safely use various hand, power, and pneumatic tools. In addition, they will build their own pine box car and race it on the last day of camp, as well as make another project to take home.

CUPCAKE CAMP (Tuition \$150 – 1 Week) GTC 7/22 – 7/26 and 8/5 – 8/9

Campers will make various cupcakes, pastries, and desserts. Kitchen etiquette, proper use of equipment and measurements will be taught. Campers will leave with the knowledge to prepare these baking specialties at home for personal enjoyment or special occasions. The week will culminate with campers participating in a baking challenge/competition.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE CAMP (Tuition \$150 – 1 Week) PC 7/15 – 7/19

Environmental Science Camp will excite budding scientists with topics such as ecology, soil science, geology, geography, and ecosystems. Campers will also explore topics such as land use, water quality, and stewardship, and will learn about the various environmental agencies. Campers will participate in several hands-on activities throughout the week and will build a terrarium to take home on the final day of camp.

JUNIOR CHEF COOKING CAMP– LEVEL 1 for first time campers

(Tuition \$150 – 1 Week) GTC 7/8 – 7/12 and PC 7/29 – 8/2

Campers will learn the skills needed to create a variety of appetizers, entrees, and desserts utilizing many common ingredients and local fresh produce in an air-conditioned space. Campers will also learn about safety, nutrition, and the proper use of kitchen equipment and tools. The week will culminate with campers participating in a “Junior Chef” cook-off competition.

JUNIOR CHEF COOKING CAMP – LEVEL 2 for returning campers

(Tuition \$150 – 1 Week) GTC 7/15 – 7/19 and PC 8/5 – 8/9

Campers who have attended Jr. Chef Camp before are encouraged to register for an advanced cooking class featuring different meal preparation choices utilizing many common ingredients and local fresh produce. Campers will also learn about safety, nutrition, and the proper use of kitchen equipment and tools. The week will culminate with campers participating in a “Junior Chef” cook-off competition.

STEM ROBOTICS CAMP – Level 1 (Tuition \$300 - 2 Weeks) GTC 7/8 – 7/19 and PC 7/29 – 8/9

Participants will learn Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) principles through robotics. STEM camp is designed for students interested in learning how to design, program and build robots. They will learn from engineers and a championship winning team of For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology (FIRST) Robotics coaches and students (www.usfirst.org). On the last day of camp, students will compete in a robot competition.

STEM ROBOTICS CAMP – LEVEL 2 for returning campers (Tuition \$150 - 1 Week) GTC 7/22 – 7/26

This camp is intended for those who attended one of our Level One STEM Robotics Camps and will build on skills previously learned. The program will focus on advanced skills in design, mechanics, programming, and other robotics principles. Students will further their knowledge through the use of sensors and other advanced concepts to build more sophisticated robots for a culminating competition. Participants will learn Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) principles through robotics. On the last day of camp, students will compete in a robot competition.

THEATRE CAMP (Tuition \$550 – 4+ Weeks) GTC 7/8 – 8/2

Theatre Camp is designed for middle school students who want to explore interests, potential, and opportunities in the Arts. Campers will receive instruction in multiple theatrical disciplines including dance, theatre, and vocal music. The program will focus on jazz and musical theatre forms of dance, dramatic character development and acting techniques, as well as vocal instruction in solo and ensemble performance. The camp will culminate with a live musical theatre performance of *Hairspray* in the professional CCTS Black Box Theatre. Instruction will be provided by certified master-level teachers with professional theatre and music backgrounds. Camp counselors will be current college students studying music and theatre. The live-performances will be done collaboratively with the high school summer musical. **PLEASE NOTE:** Camp runs 8 am to 3 pm except for Tech Week which runs July 22 to July 26. During this week, all campers report from noon to 9 pm. Please plan accordingly.

VIDEO PRODUCTION/DIGITAL MEDIA CAMP (Tuition \$150 - 1 Week) GTC 7/8–7/12 and PC 7/15–7/19

Lights, camera, action! Create your own video content—from vlogs to tutorials to short films. Learn the fundamentals of pre-production and planning and use professional camera equipment to capture footage. Then, edit videos using Final Cut Pro X, a professional editing software. Whether you like to be in front of the camera or behind-the-scenes, this is the perfect opportunity to express your creativity!
